



VEREDICTUM COOKIE POLICY

Effective Date: May 1, 2026

This Cookie Policy explains how **VEREDICTUM, INC.**, (“Verdictum,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on its websites, platform, dashboards, and related digital services (collectively, the “Platform”).

This Cookie Policy should be read together with our **Privacy Policy, General Terms of Use**, and any other privacy or data-processing terms made available by Verdictum.

1. What Cookies Are

Cookies are small text files placed on a user’s device when visiting a website or using an online service. Cookies may allow a website or platform to recognize a device, maintain a secure session, remember preferences, measure usage, improve functionality, or support other technical and operational purposes.

Similar technologies may include local storage, session storage, pixels, tags, software development kits, tracking links, device identifiers, or other technologies that store or access information on a user’s device.

2. How Verdictum Uses Cookies

Verdictum may use cookies and similar technologies to:

- a) operate the Platform;
- b) maintain secure login sessions;
- c) authenticate users;
- d) protect accounts, case files, and Platform integrity;
- e) remember user preferences;
- f) process payments or support billing functionality;
- g) measure Platform performance and website usage;
- h) improve user experience and technical functionality;
- i) detect, prevent, and investigate fraud, abuse, security incidents, or unauthorized access; and
- j) where permitted and subject to applicable consent requirements, support analytics or marketing on Verdictum’s public website.

3. Public Website and Private Platform

Verdictum distinguishes between its public website and its private dispute-resolution environment.

On the **public website**, Verdictum may use strictly necessary cookies and, where permitted, functional, analytics, or marketing cookies subject to applicable consent requirements.



Within the **private Platform**, including dashboards and case-management areas, Veredictum intends to use cookies and similar technologies primarily for strictly necessary, security, authentication, session-management, technical, and operational purposes.

Within **arbitration or dispute-resolution case files**, Veredictum does not intend to use cookies or similar technologies for advertising, retargeting, or commercial profiling based on case-file activity.

4. Categories of Cookies We May Use

4.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are required for the Platform to function properly. They may be used for login, authentication, session management, security, fraud prevention, load balancing, payment flow integrity, and access-control functions.

Because these cookies are necessary to provide the Platform and its core services, they generally cannot be disabled through Veredictum's cookie preference tools.

4.2. Security Cookies

These cookies and similar technologies help protect accounts, users, case files, and the Platform. They may be used to detect suspicious activity, prevent unauthorized access, support multi-factor authentication, maintain audit logs, and protect the integrity of proceedings.

4.3. Functional Cookies

Functional cookies allow the Platform or website to remember user choices, settings, language preferences, interface preferences, or other functionality that improves the user experience.

4.4. Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies help Veredictum understand how users interact with its public website or Platform, measure performance, identify technical issues, and improve services.

Where required by applicable law, analytics cookies will be used only with consent or in a manner permitted by applicable law.

4.5. Marketing and Advertising Cookies

Marketing and advertising cookies may be used on Veredictum's public website to measure campaigns, understand referral sources, or deliver relevant communications.

Veredictum does not intend to use marketing or advertising cookies inside private case files or arbitration workspaces.

Where required by applicable law, marketing and advertising cookies will be used only with the user's prior consent.



5. Third-Party Cookies and Service Providers

Some cookies or similar technologies may be placed or operated by third-party service providers used by Veredictum, such as hosting providers, cybersecurity providers, payment processors, analytics providers, customer-support tools, or communications providers.

These providers may process information in accordance with their own terms and privacy notices, as well as any agreements with Veredictum.

Veredictum may update its service providers from time to time.

6. Consent and Preference Management

Where required by applicable law, Veredictum will request consent before using non-essential cookies or similar technologies.

Users may be provided with cookie controls allowing them to accept, reject, or manage non-essential cookies. Available options may depend on the user's location, applicable law, browser settings, and the relevant Veredictum service.

Users may also manage cookies through their browser settings. Blocking or deleting cookies may affect the availability, security, or functionality of the Platform.

Strictly necessary cookies cannot be disabled through Veredictum's cookie preference tools because they are required for the Platform to operate.

7. Do Not Track and Similar Signals

Some browsers or devices may offer "Do Not Track" or similar signals. Because there is no uniform industry standard for responding to such signals, Veredictum may not respond to them unless required by applicable law.

Where legally required, Veredictum will honor applicable opt-out preference signals in the manner required by law.

8. Cookie Inventory

The table below identifies the cookies and similar technologies used by Veredictum. This table must be completed and periodically reviewed by Veredictum's technical team before publication and whenever cookies, vendors, or tracking technologies change.

9. Information for the Technical Team

Before this Cookie Policy is published, the technical team should confirm, at minimum:

- all cookies used on the public website;
- all cookies used inside the private Platform;
- all local storage, session storage, pixels, SDKs, tags, tracking links, or similar technologies;
- all third-party providers that place or access cookies or similar technologies;
- whether any analytics, advertising, retargeting, heatmap, session-recording, CRM, or campaign-tracking tools are used;
- the duration of each cookie or technology;
- whether each cookie is strictly necessary or non-essential;
- whether each cookie is used before or only after consent; and
- whether any tracking occurs inside private case files or arbitration workspaces.

10. Changes to This Cookie Policy

Verdictum may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in technology, law, service providers, Platform functionality, or Verdictum practices.

The updated version will be posted on the Platform or website with a new effective date.
